## Curriculum Update

Math: This week in math we have been focusing on dividing whole numbers. Students are currently working towards dividing 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers. Students have utilized multiple strategies learned from last year and were shown an all partials method and the standard method for long division. It is important for students to practice this skill along with their multiplication facts. On Thursday, students worked on solving division problems with divisors like 10 or 100 , (i.e. $4200 \div 70$ ). Students also worked on creating word problems that corresponded to a division equation. On Friday, students practiced by solving various equations. On Monday of next week we will have a quiz on multiplication on division.

Reading: This week in reading our students continued working with on their unit 2 essay. Students crafted their second proof paragraph and their conclusion. After completing their essay students worked with a partner to peer edit their writing piece. Next, students read about another athlete that overcame a challenge, Jim Abbott. Students then identified Jim's factors for success and compared and contrasted these factors with that of Jackie Robinson.

Social Studies/Science: In science this week we continued our unit on ecosystems. On Wednesday, students completed a Nearpod about Biomes. Upon completion of the Nearpod activity students began a biomes project that is described in their google classroom. Students took a quiz on Friday.

This unit will involve some vocabulary which you may find here. Next week, we will continue our study of ecosystems by learning about different biomes.
