

"Meet the Teacher" for new kindergarten students on tracks 1, 2 and 3 is scheduled on Friday, July 14th from 4:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Friday, August 4th from 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. for track 4 new kindergarten children. Student rosters will be posted during the "Meet the Teacher" evening.

Curriculum Update

Math: In math this week our Rockin' Crocs continued to review. We started with adding and subtracting fractions. We reviewed the methods that work best for us and completed several multiple choice EOG style questions. Next, we reviewed multiplication of fractions. We took some time reviewing methods and specific word problem styles they may encounter. Finally we finished the week reviewing division of fractions. This concept is somewhat easy, but when we work in a rush we tend to make simple mistakes. On Friday, students took a sample "pop" quiz on all four operations involving fractions. Next week we will continue to review when we are in math. Students were also provided a study guide that will provide insight to types of problems our students may face during the EOGs.

Reading: In Reading this week we took some time and reviewed some "good reading" strategies utilizing a couple of nearpod activities. We also completed several EOG practice passages. Our students did pretty well with the passages. I will say that the poem passage and questions was certainly more difficult and tripped up quite a few of our students. During our daily 5 time our students have been working on compiling information for science into a newspaper. During this time, Mr. T has been completing our end of year benchmarking. This information will be in Friday folders tomorrow. In Writing, our students are finishing their final research report drafts. They also began writing their 5th Grade essay which is due on Monday, June 19th.

Science: In science this week, our students continued reviewing a couple specific areas for the science EOG on Monday. We started by reviewing motion and design, our very first science unit. We took notes, played a couple of educational games and completed a motion and design study guide. We then turned focus to ecosystems. We played sever interactive "kahoot" games, took some notes, completed a near pod about chemical and physical changes and students were provided a study guide.

I Can... In order to bring purpose to what your child is learning, we post I CAN statements on our board daily. It is important that your child is continually utilizing these to evaluate their understanding. You can check in with your student by discussing the following statements.

Math:

- Make a line plot to display a data
- I can determine the volume by counting unit cubes.
- I can solve volume related real world problems.
- I can convert measurements within the same measuring system

Reading:

 I can read nonfiction text and apply comprehension strategies like annotations and box and bullets to understand the main idea and supporting details

Writing

 I can take notes on a non-fiction article by using note cards and/or drawing sketches and using captions to understand what I've read.

• I can apply my understanding of the 7 life processes to explain how multicellular and unicellular organisms are both living.
